

OFFICIAL MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF June 25, 2018

The Village Council met on the above date at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order and present were Richard Clark, Paul Summers, Janet Pflaum, Judith Anderson and Carol O'Dell. Absent Carl Klingler, Gary Ulm and Tresa Hundley.

Opened with silent prayer and followed by reciting Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion made by Paul Summers to approve June 11, 2018, minutes. Seconded by Judy Anderson. All voting Aye.

Mosquito spraying is being done in the Village on Tuesday & Thursday nights.

The Noble Village Hall will be closed Wednesday, July 4.

Village has reserved 2 tents for the Noble Chowder.

Personnel Committee meeting was scheduled for Thursday, July 5 at 6p.m. at the Noble Village Hall.

Mayor Clark had looked at the bridge at 237 E. South Ave. and advised the board that the bridge boards are rotten and left it up to the owners what they would like to do.

Motion made by Judy Anderson to approve Ordinance for making Appropriation for the payment of the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Village of Noble for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2018 Total Revenue estimate \$452,917.00 and Expenditures \$646,835.00 and difference \$193,918.00. Seconded by Carol O'Dell. Roll Call Vote Taken, All voting Aye except Paul Summers voting no. Motion passed.

Motion made by Mayor Richard Clark to pass and adopt the Ordinance of the Village of Noble, Richland County, Illinois ascertaining Prevailing Rate of Wages for Laborers, Workmen and Mechanics employed on public works of said Village with the Richland County Prevailing Wage. Seconded by Paul Summers. Roll Call Vote Taken, All voting Aye except Janet Pflaum voting no. Motion passed.

Discussion regarding a tree S of 255 W. Elm St. Tree is not on Village property. No action.

Replacement of sidewalks in three different areas (Mayor Clark provided each board member 3 options of areas to replace): 1) East side of N. Noble Ave between E. North (250) and Elm St. approximately 360 feet; 2) North side of the 200 block of E. Poplar St. approximately 640 feet; 3) In front of Ronda June Inc. approximately 100 feet. Mayor Clark discussed with Charleston Engineering and was given an estimate of \$40.00 per linear foot. Matter tabled until Sidewalk Committee meets and makes recommendation.

Trustee Anderson asked about weeds on Palmer St. by Hogrun being sprayed. No action taken.

Motion made by Paul Summers to pay bills. Seconded by Carol O'Dell. All voting Aye.

Motion made by Paul Summers to adjourn the meeting at 7:35 p.m. Seconded by Carol O'Dell. All voting Aye.
