The Village Council met on the above date at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order and present were Richard Clark, Tresa Hundley, Carl Klingler, Gary Ulm, Paul Summers, Janet Pflaum, Judith Anderson and Carol O'Dell.

Opened with silent prayer and followed by reciting Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion made by Janet Pflaum to approve October 9, 2018, minutes. Seconded by Gary Ulm. All voting Aye.

Tax Levy estimate with 4.99% increase over last year calculations was provided to the board at a total of \$75,436.00. Motion made by Gary Ulm to approve the total estimate of the Tax Levy in the amount of \$75,436.00 (4.99% increase from last year). Seconded by Judith Anderson. Roll Call Vote Taken, All voting Aye with exception of Paul Summers voting no and Carl Klingler voting no. Motion carried.

Addendum #1 to the Contract for refuse collection within the Village limits between the Village of Noble and Republic Services of Indiana which will be effective February 1 with a five year option; Village clean up two times per year; Service day will be Wednesday; all other terms and conditions remain the same; Contract price will be \$13.50 per month per home and annual price adjustment will be 2.5-3.0%. Motion made by Carol O'Dell to accept the contract/addendum with Republic for refuse collection inside the Village limits. Seconded by Judith Anderson. Roll Call Vote Taken, All voting Aye.

Village Christmas party is scheduled for December 11 at 6:00p.m. at the Olde Tyme Steakhaus.

An invoice from Floyd's Welding Service in the amount of \$539.00 for a plate that was installed in the Village State truck and it is not a flat plate which is what the Mayor wanted. Mayor Clark will check into this so put a hold on the invoice for now.
