

COVID-19 Updates

COVID-19 continues to be top of mind, and we have been actively monitoring updates from the CDC, State of Illinois, and the Richland County Health Office to help us manage through this rapidly evolving situation.

As of 3/17/2020, the Village of Noble has taken action on the following items in response to the COVID-19 outbreak:

- The Village of Noble Village Hall will be closed to the public through 3/31/2020. Village staff will continue to report to work and will be available by phone or e-mail to assist the public. Various pieces of information and contact information can be found on this website.
- For those residents that need to pay a bill, you can do so in the following ways only:
 1. The "PSN" icon and/or Pay Utility Bill link on this website
 2. Placing your payment into the dropbox to the left of the front door of Village Hall or Red Box
 3. Via regular mail
 4. Via online bill pay through your banking website
- The Village of Noble will waive March's non-payment disconnections, and will waive April's late fees for those customers that have difficulty making payments via these temporary arrangements
- All current events planned for the Noble Park will be cancelled through 3/31/2020
- All public safety personnel will operate normal shifts and will provide normal coverage
- Public Works departments will continue to operate as normal
- Trash pick up will collect on normal route days

Also, the Village of Noble, in conjunction with the Noble Little League, will be cancelling all use of said field through April 30th.

The decision was made in a joint effort to protect the citizens of Noble and its youth. This action was taken because of the COVID-19 outbreak, and the uncertainty as to how long these current conditions might take place.
