

OFFICIAL MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF January 24, 2022

The Village Council met on the above date at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was called to order and present were Brad Kessler, Tresa Hundley, Paul Summers, Gary Ulm, Janet Pflaum, Carol O'Dell and Jana Baker. Remote attendance: Carl Klingler.

Opened with silent prayer and followed by reciting Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion made by Janet Pflaum to approve January 10, 2022 minutes. Seconded by Jana Baker. All voting Aye.

Board was provided Statement of Economic Interests to complete and return.

Mayor Kessler informed the Board that the Village employees picked up the sidewalk on the west side of 300 block of S. Noble Ave. and placed a pipe for drainage for right now. Mayor Kessler said when better weather comes the sidewalk will need reformed and re-poured.

Cornerstone Way is an alley and the Village does not maintain alleys. No action taken.

Mayor Kessler spoke to the property owner and occupant of 237 E. Poplar St. regarding parking along the street causing issues for other residents. The land owner told Mayor Kessler there is additional parking in the back of the residence that could be used and she would talk with her daughter who lives there. Trustee Baker inquired if there would be a sign put up for no parking and was told by Mayor Kessler not at this time. Mayor Kessler had talked with the Village Attorney Barry Bright and upon their discussion (ordinance would need done, tickets issued and process of pursuing tickets) it was Mayor Kessler's opinion to wait on no parking for the street.

Motion made by Gary Ulm to convene into executive session at 7:15 p.m. under Section 2(c)(1) to discuss the Village Treasurer's work performance and issues pertaining to working remote. Seconded by Paul Summers. All voting Aye.

Reconvened into open session at 8:20 p.m. No action taken from Executive Session.

Motion made by Jana Baker to pay bills. Seconded by Carol O'Dell. All voting Aye.

Motion made by Carol O'Dell to adjourn the meeting at 8:25 p.m. Seconded by Jana Baker. All voting Aye.
